

MM Soft-touch Pinion Snubber (MMPS)

Read all instructions before beginning work. Following instructions in the proper sequence will ensure the best and easiest installation.

- 1. Safety first –if you are not sure you can do the installation seek the help of a professional mechanic.
- 2. Most Mustangs have a factory pinion snubber, which needs to be replaced when installing performance lowering springs.
- Maximum Motorsports includes a unique pinion snubber with each set of H&R springs. While only slightly shorter, the unique cone design creates a soft-touch pinion snubber - you won't even notice its doing its job.
- 4. The pinion snubber is located on a bracket which is located on the chassis directly above the front part of the differential.
- 5. Remove the factory pinion snubber bracket (3 bolts), then remove the factory pinion snubber from that bracket (1 nut).
- 6. Attach the new Maximum Motorsports soft-touch pinion snubber with the supplied hardware and then reinstall the bracket onto the chassis.
